Title: Nebraska Right to Abortion Initiative

Full Text: All persons shall have a fundamental right to abortion until fetal viability, or when needed to protect the life or health of the pregnant patient, without “interference” from the state or its political subdivisions. Fetal viability means the point in pregnancy when, in the professional judgment of the patient's treating health care practitioner, there is a significant likelihood of the fetus' sustained survival outside the uterus without the application of extraordinary medical measures.

No one should have the “right” to end the life of an innocent child. In the United States, we are guaranteed the Right to Life.

“HEALTH” is too broad. Courts have determined this to mean unlimited abortion, even for financial or family reasons

Ambiguous terminology that leaves the definition of “viable” in the hands of the abortionist.

This is purposefully worded so children can be coerced into having abortions without parental consent.

This amendment eliminates basic health & safety standards designed to protect women.

This creates a clear conflict of interest as viability will be determined by the person financially incentivized to sell an abortion.

This is too broad. “Extraordinary” could mean ANY type of life-preserving measures, even readily available medicine like insulin.
